

**MINUTES OF THE NORTH BARRINGTON PLAN COMMISSION MEETING
WHICH WAS HELD DECEMBER 10, 2007 AT THE NORTH BARRINGTON VILLAGE
HALL, 111 OLD BARRINGTON ROAD, IN SAID VILLAGE**

1. Call to Order and Roll Call

At 7:3 P.M. Chairman Martin Pais called the meeting to order and the Deputy Clerk called the roll:

2. Approve Minutes: Plan Commission Meeting –November 12, 2007

The Minutes of the November 12, 2007 Plan Commission Meeting were made available to the Commission

Motion: Bill Bishop moved that the Minutes of the November 12, 2007 Plan Commission Meeting be approved as amended; seconded by David Wilford.

Discussion: There was no discussion.

Chairman Martin Pais declared the Minutes of the November 12, 2007 Plan Commission Meeting approved and put on file.

3. P.O.D.S. (Portable on Demand Storage) Ordinance Discussion

The Commission reviewed the document in their packet containing revised language to the Village Code 10-5-2: Parking and Storage Regulations. Chairman Martin Pais has drafted wordage pertaining to the use of P.O.D.S. (Portable on Demand Storage) in the Village. The intent is to prevent residents from placing storage containers on their property for undetermined periods of time.

The Commission discussed some clarification of the generic definition of storage containers, both permanent and portable. David Wilford suggested more specific language pertaining to the size, aesthetics and classification of such storage containers. Storage trailers for construction purposes were also discussed.

Motion: Camille Koertner moved that the Commission recommend to the Village Board amending the Village Code 10-5-2; seconded by Denis Taillon. The changes are: Village Code 10-5-2 Section A: add the words **portable storage containers that cannot be shielded as set**

forth in paragraph B. Village Code 10-5-2 Section B: add the words **storage containers.**
Village Code 10-5-2 Section C **4.A:** add the word **construction.** Add the paragraph under
Village Code 10-5-2 Section C **4.B. Storage Containers/Trailers for storage/Dumpsters:**
**Storage containers/trailers/dumpsters not so shielded may be used incidental to moving
into or out of the premises. Such trailers may be parked for a period not to exceed fourteen
(14) days upon issuance to the property owner of a permit as provided in this chapter.
Temporary parking for a period in excess of fourteen (14) days may be permitted only by
action of the Village Hall.**

Discussion: There was some discussion.
