

**MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE PARKS AND RECREATION

1. Call to Order, Roll Call, Approve Minutes of September 10, 2007 Parks & Recreation Commission Meeting:

At 7:37 P.M Chairman Kathy Kubick called the meeting to order and called the roll:

The Minutes from the September 10, 2007 Parks and Recreation Commission Meeting were made available to the Commission. There were some changes made to the minutes.

Motion: Andrew Seagren moved to approve the Minutes from the September 10, 2007 Parks and Recreation Commission Meeting as amended; seconded by Vice Chairman Cathy Howes.

Discussion: There was some discussion.

Vote on the Motion:

Chairman Kathy Kubick declared the Minutes of the September 10, 2007 Parks & Recreation Meeting approved as amended and put on file.

2. Update on Fall Festival

Vice Chairman Cathy Howes reviewed the responsibilities for the Fall Festival scheduled for October 7, 2007 at Eton Park. The set up of tents, chairs, tables etc. will start at 12:00 noon on Saturday by Nazario and his crew. The committee members will arrive at Eton Park Sunday October 7 at 9:00 a.m. All the details are in place and the Commission is ready for the Festival.

There was some discussion about next year's summer concerts. Andrew Seagren will begin researching bands and Trustee Boland will investigate obtaining a temporary liquor license for events held at Eton Park. Andrew Seagren will also check into the feasibility of purchasing and storing two used riser sections.

3. Update on Walking Paths and Eton Park

The Commission discussed Eton Park, which was newly reseeded. Due to the lack of rain, parts of the park may need to be reseeded. Brian Thomson will advise the Commission on the best course of action. The East Oxford walking trail is now complete with new mulch and the steps at the entrance. The total cost was \$1,645.00. Brian Thompson will cut back parts of the Biltmore Drive walking path

this fall. There was discussion about laying new mulch on this path as well as at the Eton Park playgrounds.

4. Trustee's Report

Trustee Pete Boland updated the Commission on current Village issues being discussed by the Board of Trustees.

5. New/Old Business

There has been a report by Andrew Seagren's wife of graffiti sprayed on the concrete base of the gazebo at Eton Park. The Village Administrator will assess the damage.

6. Adjournment

Motion: Jennifer Haidu made a motion to adjourn the meeting; seconded by Lloyd Struttman.

Discussion: There was no discussion.

The voice vote was unanimous in favor.
