

MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE
PARKS AND RECREATION COMMISSION OF THE
VILLAGE OF NORTH BARRINGTON WHICH WAS HELD MONDAY APRIL 4, 2005 AT THE
NORTH BARRINGTON VILLAGE HALL

1. Call to Order and Roll Call:

At 7:10 p.m. Chairman Cassidy Towne called the Meeting to order. The Deputy Clerk called the roll:

The minutes from the March 7, 2005 Parks & Recreation Commission Meeting were made available to the Commission.

Motion: Vice Chairman Kathy Kubick moved to approve the Minutes from the March 7, 2005 Parks & Recreation Commission Meeting; seconded by Chairman Cassidy Towne.

Discussion: There was no discussion.

Vote on the Motion:

The voice vote was unanimous in favor.

Chairman Cassidy Towne declared the Minutes of the March 7, 2005 meeting approved and put on file.

2. Update on Summer Camps

The Eton Park summer camps registration mailing from the Foglia YMCA has been sent to the Village residents.

3. Update on Temporary Restroom at Eton Park

The Commission discussed the plans for the temporary restroom to be installed at Eton Park in April and its proposed landscaping. They reviewed the landscaping plan designed by Brian Thomson and a diagram for a wooden structure enclosing the restroom similar to one currently located at Lourdes Park in Elgin. The Commission decided to proceed slowly with landscaping decisions so they could educate themselves on various landscaping options. They also decided

that future plans could include a wooden structure enclosing the restroom.

4. Old/New Business

Susan Allman, the Village Forester, addressed the Commission about the plans for the Arbor Day Celebration at Eton Park on May 1, 2005 from 1:00-3:00 p.m. She would like to plant a Bald Cypress tree and hold a dedication ceremony. The details of the ceremony and planting location of the Cypress tree were discussed. She announced to the Commission that the Village of North Barrington has been given the Tree City Award. Susan also would like to see a volunteer clean up at Eton Park on May 1, 2005 and is encouraging participation by residents.

The Commission also discussed the summer concerts to be held at Eton Park. The Young Souls will perform June 11, 2005 and Kraig Kenning will perform July 23, 2005. An informational mailer will be sent to the Village residents in May.

Chairman Towne informed the Commission that BASA has lined the soccer field at Eton Park for their camp. The Commission discussed the possibility of replacing the mulch underneath the play set at Eton Park.
