

North Barrington Eton Park Usage Guidelines

The purpose of these guidelines is to ensure that all participants will have equal and fair access to the park.

Eton park is a private park for the sole use of North Barrington residents and their guests. As such, requests for usage of the park is restricted to a North Barrington resident who is considered the sponsor of the event. While the park can be used by others as a guest, it must be reserved by a North Barrington resident and this person becomes the responsible party of the event. The North Barrington resident sponsor must be present at the event.

Any and all trash generated by the event must be cleaned up and any expenses incurred by the village to clean up the park after the event will be billed to the North Barrington resident sponsor.

Since the park is meant to meet the needs of North Barrington residents, any wide spread advertising of an event is prohibited. There is very limited parking at the park and any event must account for this limited parking.

Depending upon the number of requests for the park, exclusive access to the park may not be possible and a sharing of the field will have to be enforced. At no time will the Village allow for an unsafe condition to exist because of shared usage and if it becomes necessary, limiting the use of the park will be done.

The reserving of the park is on a first come, first served basis. If there are a number of requests for the park the village reserves the right to restrict the number of days and times a person can reserve the park.

No team or event is allowed to store or leave team equipment at the park unless previously approved by the Village. Any equipment left at the park may be removed and disposed of at any time without warning.

Alcohol is prohibited at the park and the park closes at dusk.

If the soccer goals are moved, they must be re-staked into the ground. This is a law in Illinois. Failure to re-secure the soccer goals will result in loss of privilege to use the park for future events.

Finally - the park sits in the middle of a quiet neighborhood. We ask that you remind your guests of this fact and respect the peace and quiet of the neighborhood and remind them not to park on lawns.
