

MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE PARKS AND RECREATION COMMISSION OF  
THE VILLAGE OF NORTH BARRINGTON WHICH WAS HELD MONDAY AUGUST 15, 2005  
AT THE NORTH BARRINGTON VILLAGE HALL

1. Call to Order and Roll Call:

At 7:35 p.m. Chairman Cassidy Towne called the meeting to order. The Deputy Clerk called the roll:

Motion: Vice Chairman Kathy Kubick moved to approve the Minutes from the July 11, 2005 Parks & Recreation Commission Meeting; seconded by Cathy Howes.

Discussion: There was no discussion.

Vote on the Motion:

Chairman Cassidy Towne declared the Minutes of the July 11, 2005 Meeting approved and put on file.

2. Welcome New Parks Commission Member Bill Bowyer

Chairman Cassidy Towne introduced new member Bill Bowyer to the Commission and welcomed him.

3. Discussion of July Concert

Vice Chairman Kathy Kubick gave a brief report of the concert that was held July 23, 2005 at Eton Park. There were approximately 100 people in attendance. The Commission decided that one outdoor concert at Eton Park in the summertime was sufficient in the future. They decided that although the sale of food was not necessary, they would leave the option open for future concerts.

4. Discussion of Eton Park Movie Night in August

Vice Chairman Kubick outlined her plans for an outdoor movie night at Eton Park. She will conduct a trial show on August 27, 2005 at Eton Park. The Commission discussed possible movies to be shown.

5. Update on Fall Festival and Sponsorship

Vice Chairman Kubick updated the Commission on the progress of the Fall Festival scheduled for September 25, 2005 from 1:00p.m. to 4:00p.m. at Eton Park. She is finalizing the Village mailing. Chairman Cassidy Towne has Catch 22 Petting Zoo reserved and the tent rental from Taylor Rental confirmed. The Deputy Clerk will schedule mosquito spraying, extermination of the bees nest in the swing set, the delivery of three temporary restrooms, and additional dumpsters and liners from Waste Management. The Commission will hold a separate meeting following the Labor Day holiday. Chairman Towne will follow up with Trustee Jane Farrell regarding the possible sponsorship by State Bank and Trust.

6. Update on Mulching of East Oxford Trail

The Commission asked about the status of the walking trail and the requested work to clear the path and define its width. The Deputy Clerk will contact the Village President for a status report.

7. Discussion of Fall Soccer at Eton Park

Eton Field is ready for the Fall Soccer season and the Deputy Clerk has begun taking reservations for the soccer fields.

8. Barrington Park District Pool Membership

The Commission decided that they would encourage Village residents to purchase their Barrington Park District pool pass during the early bird season and submit the receipt to the Village to take advantage of the Rebate Program. They would like to add this suggestion to the next Seasons Newsletter.
