

MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE PARKS AND RECREATION COMMISSION OF  
THE VILLAGE OF NORTH BARRINGTON WHICH WAS HELD MONDAY, JANUARY 2, 2006  
AT THE NORTH BARRINGTON VILLAGE HALL

1. Call to Order and Roll Call:

At 7:30 p.m Chairman Cassidy Towne called the meeting to order. The Deputy Clerk called the roll:

The Minutes from the November 7, 2005 Parks & Recreation Commission Meeting were made available to the Commission.

Motion: Vice Chairman Kathy Kubick moved to approve the Minutes from the November 7, 2005 Parks & Recreation Commission Meeting; seconded by Lloyd Struttman.

Discussion: There was no discussion.

Vote on the Motion:

The voice vote was unanimous in favor.

Chairman Cassidy Towne declared the Minutes of the November 7, 2005 Meeting approved and put on file.

2. Update on Electricity at Eton Park

Trustee Jane Farrell informed the Commission that the Board of Trustees had approved the expenditure for having a survey completed of Eton Park in order to proceed with the installation of electricity. The Commission agreed that electricity would be an asset for the events held at Eton Park.

3. Update on East Oxford Walking Trail

Vice Chairman Kathy Kubick reported that Cathy Howes had spoken with Tom Gooch from Cuba Township about walking the trail in the spring of 2006.

4. Rebate Program

The Commission discussed the current Parks Rebate Program and possible changes. Chairman Cassidy Towne reiterated that the original purpose of the program was to offset the non-resident fees paid by North Barrington Village residents for programs taken at the Barrington Park District. Recent rebate submissions to the Village have made it necessary for the Commission to implement tighter guidelines and define which programs qualify for the rebate program. Chairman Cassidy Towne will redesign the Village of North Barrington Park District Rebate Application Form and include the necessary program restrictions.

#### 5. Old/New Business

Chairman Cassidy Towne informed the Commission that new soccer nets might be purchased in the spring.

The Commission will establish a date for the 2006 Fall Festival after Vice Chairman Kathy Kubick obtains the Homecoming date from Barrington High School. There was discussion about possible musicians.

The Commission discussed the events they would like to hold this coming summer at Eton Park, such as at least one summer concert and a movie night. The Commission will decide upon the events and dates to be included in the next Village newsletter sent to the residents.
