

MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE PARKS AND RECREATION COMMISSION OF
THE VILLAGE OF NORTH BARRINGTON WHICH WAS HELD MONDAY MARCH 7, 2005 AT
THE NORTH BARRINGTON VILLAGE HALL

1. Call to Order and Roll Call:

At 7:35 p.m. Chairman Cassidy Towne called the Meeting to order. The Deputy Clerk called the roll:

The minutes from the February 15, 2005 Parks & Recreation Commission Meeting were made available to the Commission.

Motion: Cathy Howes moved to approve the Minutes from the February 15, 2005 Parks & Recreation Commission Meeting; seconded by Chairman Cassidy Towne.

Discussion: There was no discussion.

Vote on the Motion:

Chairman Cassidy Towne declared the Minutes of the February 15, 2005 meeting approved and put on file.

2. Update on Fall Festival

The Commission agreed that the Fall Festival would be discussed at the Parks & Recreation Commission Meeting on April 4, 2005 when Vice Chairman Kathy Kubick could be in attendance to present an update.

3. Update on Summer Camps

Laurie Whitmer distributed a Foglia YMCA Summer Day Camp flyer outlining the various camps to be held this summer at Eton Park. The Ricky Raccoon Preschool Camp will be extended to a full week the first session and a Krafty Kids Camp will be added. The summer Camps flyer will be mailed to the North Barrington residents after spring break. There will be a separate flyer mailed to announce the summer concerts to be held at Eton Park.

4. Update on "permanent" restroom

The seasonal restroom has been approved and is scheduled to be delivered to Eton Park at the beginning of April. Cathy Howes passed out the Rental and Service Agreement from Crown Restrooms. The Parks & Recreation Commission will coordinate with Susan Allman on the Environmental Commission to plant a tree and design some appropriate landscaping. The Commission is planning a field trip to view a similar restroom in Elgin and in Timber Lake Estates.

5. Update on Summer Camps, BASA and Library

Laurie Whitmer explained to the Commission that BASA will sponsor a soccer camp this summer at Eton Park. BASA will be responsible for lining the field and mailing out flyers. The Barrington Area Library will hold a library read one day this summer at Eton Park

6. Old/New Business

Chairman Cassidy Towne told the Commission that \$5000 has been budgeted to hold two concerts this summer at Eton Park. The Commission is currently scheduling the musicians. Chairman Towne also said she would get the sketches from Trustee Bruce Sauer illustrating the proposed work to be done in the spring on the East Oxford Road walking trail culverts.
