

MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE PARKS AND RECREATION COMMISSION OF
THE VILLAGE OF NORTH BARRINGTON WHICH WAS HELD MONDAY, JUNE 5, 2006 AT
THE NORTH BARRINGTON VILLAGE HALL

1. Call to Order and Roll Call:

At 7:35 p.m Chairman Cassidy Towne called the meeting to order. The Deputy Village Clerk called the roll:

The Minutes from the May 1, 2006 Parks and Recreation Commission Meeting were made available to the Commission.

Motion: Vice Chairman Kathy Kubick moved to approve the Minutes from the May 1, 2006 Parks and Recreation Commission Meeting; seconded by Cathy Howes.

Discussion: There was no discussion.

Vote on the Motion:

The voice vote was unanimous in favor.

Chairman Cassidy Towne declared the Minutes of the May 1, 2006 Meeting approved and put on file.

2. Discussion Re: Summer Concert

The reminder flyer for the June 17, 2006 summer concert at Eton Park has been mailed to the Village residents. Vice Chairman Kathy Kubick showed the flyer to the Commission. Andrew Seagren confirmed that he has reserved a 16' x 20' stage for the band from the Target Rental in Arlington Heights. The cost will be \$385. The stage will be placed on the basketball court at Eton Park to prevent sinking. Mr. Seagren will work with Pat Ryan on the sound amplification requirements. The sound system will be rented from the Player's Bench in Crystal Lake, for a cost of \$175. The John Kutten Harper Jazz Combo will be performing.

3. Discussion Re: Summer Camps

Laurie Whitmer reported to the Commission that everything is in order for the start of the summer camps at Eton Park. The Deputy Clerk will order the canopy to be set up for the first Ricky Raccoon camp scheduled for June 13th, 14th and 15th. Ms. Whitmer explained that North Barrington residents were mailed a summer camp flyer directly from the Foglia YMCA if they were YMCA members. There was also a summer camp flyer mailed to residents from the Village.

4. Discussion Re: Trails

The Commission discussed the tree that was down on the walking trail in front of the Biltmore Country Club. It will be removed by Cuba Township. The Commission will also ask Cuba Township to widen and mulch the East Oxford walking trail.

5. Discussion Re: Eton Park, Bat Houses, Picnic Table

Brian Thomson has the two donated bat houses in his possession and will install them at Eton Park. Chairman Towne reported that a new swing would be purchased, as well as a new picnic table. Chairman Towne reported that the Village is not being billed by Commonwealth Edison for the electricity at Eton Park, due to its municipality status.

6. Update on Fall Festival

The Fall Festival is scheduled for October 8, 2006. Kraig Kenning is performing. Chairman Towne has the contract from Patch 22. The price for the petting zoo and hayride has increased to \$1800 this year. Vice Chairman Kathy Kubick is organizing the entertainment.

7. Old/New Business

Chairman Cassidy Towne will contact Brian Thomson regarding mosquito spraying at Eton Park prior to the June 17, 2006 summer concert.

The Commission will bring a "wish" list to the next Meeting, prioritizing projects they would like to see within the Village.

8. Adjournment

Motion: Cathy Howes made a motion to adjourn the meeting; seconded by Laurie Whitmer.

Discussion: There was no discussion.
