Chairperson David Lauffer is finalizing the 5-year Master Plan with Kimley Horn. The Commission would like to be part of the America 250 Celebration.

Trustee Creviston-Trustee Creviston reported the Village remains safe. The ad hoc committee will meet to begin discussion about the Village plans for America's 250 Anniversary celebration.

Trustee Pais – Trustee Pais reported the Village is in discussion with the Village of Lake Barrington to share engineering services and joint bidding for this year's street program. A possible intergovernmental agreement is being investigated, and formal action by the Board of Trustees may be at the May Board Meeting.

The project of the road rebuild from Signal Hill Road to the Biltmore Country Club will be evaluated once the Village has obtained three proposals. Biltmore Country Club leadership will be included in the process as some property will be needed on a temporary basis or permanent basis.

Village Staff is working with Ela Township Highway to install new delineators on Clover Hill Road that will decrease the long-term maintenance and improve the aesthetics.

Trustee Vandenberg – Trustee Vandenberg had no report.

Village President's Report

Village President Sweet McDonnell will attend the Ramadan Dinner in South Barrington on February 25, 2026. She invited the Trustees to join her.

Village President Sweet McDonnell reported she will travel to Springfield in March or April with Trustee Creviston and possibly Trustee Pais when the House of Representatives and Senate are both in session.

Village President Sweet McDonnell reported she attended the Barrington Area Chamber of Commerce Mayor's Legislative Breakfast at the Barrington White House with Village Administrator Lobaito.

Village President Sweet McDonnell explained that Hwy 59 will be closed for at least two weeks during the GHO Project. Administrator Lobaito stated a detour route will be approved during the permitting process.
