The Village of North Barrington utilizes Alan Horticulture, LLC, a private contractor, for its snow and ice removal services. They are responsible for approximately 8 miles of streets. The Village's priority is to keep the main streets open for emergency services and school buses. These are the streets that connect to state highways or Lake County roads.

Winter Salting: The Village is cognizant of minimizing the environmental impact of salting roadways. The overuse of salt (Sodium Chloride) may lead to groundwater contamination, degradation of wetlands, and damage to trees and vegetation. With this in mind, the Village minimizes its use of salt while maintaining a safe road conditions for motorists. Please be patient when driving on local streets.
